STUDENT ACCOUNTS

We offer an optional student account for school families. Parents prepay an amount to hold to pay for lunches, etc. If the expense is an optional one - milk, lunch (Subway, Dominos, etc.), special meals, etc., deductions must be authorized by a parent (in person/email/phone or marked on the form). After a deposit is made for a student account, a record will be kept of disbursements from the account. Balances will be sent home quarterly.
